Wartime Evacuees

learn about what it was like to live through the Second World War with our very own Evacuee. Children will hear a real life account of an evacuee who was sent away from home during the war.

Town Trail

take a walk round the town with one of our museum guides to learn about the history of the buildings, and compare what the high street looks like now with how it would have looked years ago.

Victorian Wash Day

try your hand at doing the washing the Victorian way! Children will learn about how wash day would have been done in the Victorian times and make comparisons between then and now. They will have the opportunity to use original washing equipment including the dolly tub and mangle.

Victorian Schoolroom

take part in a lesson in our very own Victorian school room. Learn about what children were taught in the Victorian times and how they were punished. You can also see our selection of Victorian toys and games and have a go at them yourself.

House and Home Trail

take a tour round the museum which was originally a private residence built in the Georgian period, learn about the different rooms and what they would be used for.

We have a small selection of artefact and resource loan boxes which are available for schools to borrow. The Education Team are very flexible and can adjust sessions to suit your needs.
