



## STANTON REGENERATION MONTHLY UPDATE JANUARY 2010

This is the latest monthly update to be produced by us on the Stanton Regeneration site. Updates this month are:

1. Since the last update in December there have been no meetings of the Working Groups (Housing & Social Infrastructure, Economy, Built Environment and Natural Environment, Transport). Meetings for some of the Groups are being arranged over the next few months. In the December 2009 monthly update, we stated that testing of the road options by using a specialist computer model was due to start shortly and that we anticipated that the findings of these tests would be made available around March 2010. Saint Gobain has told us that testing is now due to start in February/March 2010, with the findings being made available early June 2010 as part of the public exhibition. Saint Gobain is therefore waiting for the transport computer model for the Greater Nottingham area to be completed before testing the road options.
3. The public exhibition on the proposals being organised by Saint Gobain, will be in June 2010 at the earliest. Saint Gobain proposes to submit the planning application to us during Summer 2010 at the earliest.
