



STANTON REGENERATION NEWS UPDATE JUNE 2011

This is the latest quarterly news update to be produced by us on the Stanton Regeneration site.

1. The Saint-Gobain development team is continuing to work on their Masterplan for the site and the evidence that will form part of their future planning application to us.
2. A major part of the evidence is the traffic modelling, which the development team continues to progress. This important work involves looking at the likely traffic implications and the range of alternative access arrangements that might be required to serve a new development of this size. Saint-Gobain have commissioned expert highway consultants to carry out traffic modelling to simulate the effects of the development on the local road system so that decisions can be made on what level of highway improvements might be required for the development.
3. It is now anticipated that a planning application will be submitted to the Council around Winter 2011/Spring 2012.
