



STANTON REGENERATION MONTHLY UPDATE MARCH 2010

This is the latest monthly update to be produced by us on the Stanton Regeneration site. Updates this month are:

1. Since the last update in February there has been a meeting of the Joint Built and Natural Environment Working Group. Issues discussed focused on areas including site constraints, ecology, green infrastructure and open space, density, design and character of the street scene and buildings.
2. Testing of the road options by using a specialist computer model is due to start shortly with the findings being made available in June 2010 at the earliest as part of Saint Gobain's public exhibition.
3. The public exhibition on the proposals being organised by Saint Gobain, will be in June 2010 at the earliest. No dates have as yet been set for this and will be determined by when the transport modelling has been completed as the results from this will crucially feed in to the masterplan design. As soon as we know the dates for when Saint Gobain propose to hold the exhibition we will let you know by advertising them widely and well in advance. We have asked Saint Gobain to hold exhibitions over several days so that separate events are held at Risley, Long Eaton, Ilkeston and at the Stanton site.
4. Saint Gobain has informed us that they propose to submit the planning application to us during Summer 2010 at the earliest.
5. Anyone who wishes to make any comments on the site can send them to us at any time, using the contact details below. All comments will be used to inform discussions and the masterplan process.
